- The Exam Facilitation Specialist will supply local testing center information and set it up for you upon your acceptance of a testing center, date and time.
- You may retake the proctored exam, if necessary, AFTER you have completed your case study.

- Download your case study research materials as soon as possible, at least before your free 60-day trial expires.
